### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

The Energetix College of BioEnergetic Medicine offers practitioners who utilize BioEnergetic testing methods the tools and resources needed to refine and expand their techniques to the greatest potential. Practitioners who use either a BioEnergetic testing device or muscle testing will learn how to guide their patients in a progression from degenerative conditions to long-term healthy maintenance programs through the development of individualized protocols. An important feature of the College is the focus on individualized medicine— both in the sense of the practitioner’s own individualized approach and the patient’s individualized care.
